To increase the success of any bird control product installation, a thorough cleanup and disinfecting of bird droppings and debris should be done. Pigeons are by far the most prevalent pest bird in urban settings. Pigeons can now be found just about everywhere, and unfortunately, so can their droppings. A well-fed bird can easily create 25 pounds of droppings annually. This debris can carry any of 60 transmittable diseases, including histoplasmosis, cryptococcosis and psittacosis. What's more, pigeon droppings are not only unsightly, but their acids can eat into metal, plastic, wood and even stone. Over time, this can deface and damage buildings, vehicles, trees, shrubs, lawns, benches and park fountains.

Harmful Dusts

Inhalation of dried pigeon droppings can allow harmful bacteria and gases to enter the body, causing respiratory issues and sickness. When maintenance, construction and cleaning crews are deployed to clean pigeon droppings, it's important to provide proper PPE to protect them from potential contamination of pest bird droppings.

6 Tips to Successfully Cleanup Bird Droppings

- 1. Wet droppings before you scrape them up. Cleaning dry bird droppings can be extremely hazardous; the dry feces can be inhaled by the person cleaning them up. Bird droppings can carry any of 60 transmittable diseases, always dampen dried bird droppings before cleaning.
- 2. Physically scrape up bird droppings and dispose in a double bag. Once the droppings have been thoroughly soaked, scape them into a double strength plastic bag. Wet droppings can get heavy, you do not want the bags to break leaving a mess and health hazard in route to disposal.
- **3.** Use Waste Digester to loosen hard to get areas. There will undoubtedly be areas that are caked with droppings that are hard to reach. Soften and loosen them up with Waste Digester, a biochemical live enzyme that breaks down the bird droppings.
- 4. Inspect the area for damage and make necessary repairs. Bird droppings are acidic and can quickly eat away at building materials. It is ideal to make all of the repairs before you install permanent bird control devices.
- 5. Pressure wash, then disinfect. After scrapping away the bulk of the bird droppings, do a good power wash and then disinfect the area to eliminate any residual oder and bacteria.
- 6. How clean does it need to be? This depends on the building and what is housed in it. A hospital, medical building or food processing plant will most likely have stricter guidelines that a warehouse or airplane hangar. Be sure to check with the building owner on safety enforcements for the building you are cleaning.
